Beginning of the 3rd millennium.

Fires, floods, earthquakes, hurricanes in our media. These events, rare and distant, seem to infiltrate our daily lives and come closer to our reality. Moments of brutal upheaval with the established order, **natural disasters precede chaos and desolation.**

How do we respond to the victims? How do we deal with the mental health consequences of environmental disasters? **How do we cope when nature breaks loose?**

Herodotus writes how, in 479 BC, he witnessed the "great tide" that submerged the Greek city of Potidea, then under siege from the Persians. Without realizing it, he was writing the first description of a tsunami in the Mediterranean.

A sea now under close surveillance.

All around the globe, **the four elements are raging.** Stronger and stronger. More and more often. Fire and its out-of-control blazes and heat domes engulf forests and homes. The air stirs in storms, tornadoes and devastating cyclones. Water from the sky and sea sweeps everything in its path. The earth explodes in earthquakes and volcanoes.

An avalanche of surreal images from around the world. A flood of images from our overseas territories and mainland France. Between distress and despair, between destitution and mourning, **what are the psychotraumas linked to natural disasters?** Do they call for a different response, a specific organization, a **rethought mobilization?**

What if we were to discuss these four elements with the professionals who work with us in the field? Emergency workers, scientists, firefighters, sailors, local councillors, journalists and others, to work better together.

Faced with nature, humanity looks at itself in the mirror of powerlessness. Natural disasters can awaken ancestral fears and provide a magnet for sectarian aberrations.

How can we understand these fears and identify the risks so as to prevent them more effectively? **What resilience and rebound strategies can we suggest?**

In the face of distress and destruction, **how can we care for those who are on the front line, helping, caring,** supporting and informing in these no longer exceptional situations? Even when our survival is in rivalry with that of others, even when we risk being swept away by the panicking crowd, even when fear proves contagious, surviving in the midst of chaos often brings out a treasure trove of ingenuity and humanity.

Unsuspected feats of solidarity in action, converging factors of **collective resilience:** enough enthusiasm for us to get involved right away in the treatment of these **so singular psychotraumas.**



Dr. Ciottone is an international expert in emergency and disaster medicine, with over 25 years' clinical and field experience in aeromedical helicopter service, including at the scene of the September 11 attacks.
